Testing Out to Earn High School Credit

A student who desires to receive credit for a high school course without enrolling in the course may do so by attaining a grade of not less than a C+ (77%) for the final exam in the course.

Successfully attained credit under this policy will earn a grade of "pass" and shall not be used in computations of grade point average nor counted toward the total required credits for graduation.

The final exam used for each course will be determined by the BWMCA staff based on its assessment of the content standards and expectations for the course being tested. Students testing out will be provided a list of the general content and skills that will be assessed on the exam. It will be the responsibility of the student to prepare for the exam.

Test out exams will take place in the Blue Water Middle College Academy office or another location determined by the BWMCA staff. Test out exams will be scheduled shortly before or shortly after the fall or winter semester. Other testing dates may be arranged, if appropriate and agreed upon by BWMCA staff.
